Who is on the Hawaiian Roll?

Anyone who registered directly with Kana'iolowalu as well as ancestrally-confirmed persons who registered with Kau Inoa, Operation 'Ohana and the Hawaiian Registry through the Office of Hawaiian Affairs ("OHA") are on the Roll. Persons of all ages are on the Roll, including 'ōpio and keiki under the age of 18.

Persons who are deceased remain on the Roll because their descendants may have future rights as a result of their kupuna being on the Roll.
